



12th Annual UO Marble Workshop

Dates: June 18-24, 2007

The workshop is an intensive seven-day experience in traditional and contemporary approaches to marble carving. Instruction includes carving with hand tools, pneumatic chisels, diamond saws, and various polishing techniques. Each participant has a work-stand and access to workshop equipment.

Professors Laura Alpert and Tom Urban instruct the UO Marble Carving Workshop with guest instructors and artists David Miller, Stephanie Robison and Daniel Michael.

Costs and Supplies

Credits: 4 undergraduate/graduate

Tuition: \$490

Materials/equipment fee: \$175

About one cubic foot of marble is included, larger pieces may be available for purchase. The fee also includes access to a variety of grinders, diamond blades, pneumatic tools and chisels, files, polishing materials, and other tools. Participants will be able to experiment with a variety of specialized equipment. Safety glasses, gloves, and hearing protection will also be provided.

Basic stone carving hand tools—hammer, point and chisel—will be available. However, please bring your own stone carving tools if you have them, as the number of tools available will be limited. Some additional tools will be available for purchase.

Food and Housing

Basic lunches are provided. All other meals, housing and transportation are the responsibility of the participant. Inexpensive dorm space will be available. Clothing

Expect rain or shine and 65-75 degree weather. All participants should bring rain gear, sturdy shoes or boots, and protective clothing. The class will be held outside under shelter. Do not wear sandals.

Eligibility

Summer Session is open to everyone—there are no admission requirements to meet before you enroll in a course. **Stone carving is physically demanding, especially in a concentrated workshop format.** Participants need to be 16 years or older.
