Wayne reprises his role of the earlier movie True Grit. The story follows aging U.S. marshal Rooster Cogburn as he chases the bad guys. The critics consistently gave this film bad reviews. So, you ask, why are we watching a poor variant of a better film? The answer is simple. Much of Rooster Cogburn was filmed right here in Deschutes County. Our challenge is to see if we can spot the local shots. It should be fun.

The Four Feathers

The Four Feathers is based on a 1902 adventure novel by the British author A.E.W. Mason. The book has inspired seven movies (1915, 1921, 1929, 1939, 1955, 1977, and 2002). We will be watching the 1939 version. The story follows the adventures of a man accused of cowardice as he proves to all that he possesses great courage and is no coward. In the process he saves the lives of his friends and wins back the heart of his fiancée. The setting has some messages for today, since the movie takes place as the world's most powerful empire (great Britain) becomes involved in battling Moslem warriors in the Sudan. Though the story is fiction, the setting is based on actual events that took place in the late 19th century.
