Weekly 30-45 minute sessions. Personalized goals and lesson plans to meet needs of each individual participant.



Horses for Heroes Veterans Outreach Program

10 week 60 minute sessions. Both ground and mounted activities to help reduce PTSD symptoms, stress, anxiety, depression and other physical symptoms.
