



Oregon Consortium of Family Networks

The Oregon Consortium of Family Networks (OCFN), established in 2012, empowers families to foster confidence and opportunities for children and youth up to age 21 with disabilities, supporting them to live full and enriching lives while strengthening both their families and communities.

OCFN is made up of six family network organizations that serve 20 counties in Oregon. They provide support to families through events, advocacy, DD systems and special education navigation, crisis navigation, training, peer support groups, accessible resources and 1:1 support. Through their work, OCFN helps families become healthier units, stronger advocates for their children, and active community members. By collaborating with partner organizations and leveraging volunteers, family networks build sustainable support systems and understanding in local communities.

The Impact: From 2024-2025, family networks served over 8,000 families across Oregon. They delivered 320 trainings, impacting over 3,000 families and professionals. OCFN is also involved in bringing the lived experience of families to tables where decisions about services and supports are made, and attended 1000+ community meetings during the past year.

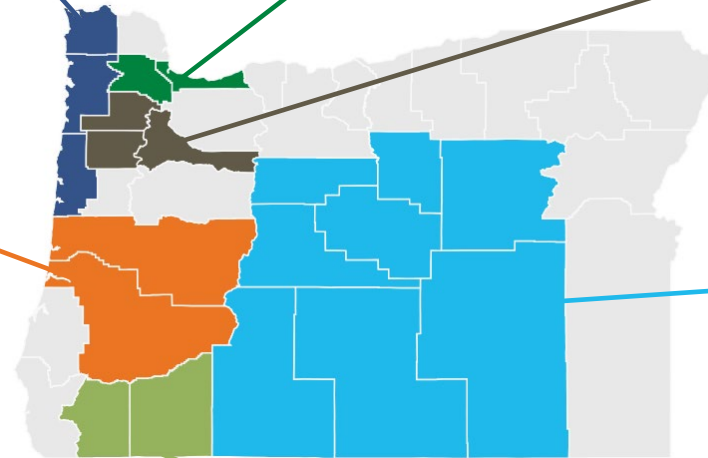
