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SHS is designed as a source of emergency resources for IDD/Referred individuals and families. Services that are offered through the Supportive Housing Services Program are as follows: (*Funding is limited and is not to exceed \$5000 a month for the remainder of FY 25-26)

- List of emergency services provided
 - Emergency Motel Assistance (Housing Plan/SHS Documents Completed)
 *Resources are limited 2 Weeks maximum
 - Deposit/Move-In Assistance
 - Application Fee/s
 - Household supplies/Furniture (Community Warehouse/Low Cost Goods on Retail)
 - Transportation (monthly/daily passes, gas cards)
 - Emergency Clothing/Shoes (weather related/replace lost/stolen items)
 - Document purchases (State ID/DL/Birth Certificate, etc.)
 - Work Related Items (clothing, boots, certificate costs, etc.)
 - o Past Due Utilities/Shut off costs or Reinstatement for new service
 - Food items (dietary needs or in case no SNAP benefits or cash available)
 - Auto Repair/light maintenance
 - School/Training supplies
 - o Items for Disability needs based on need/funding availability
