# Shake and Spill

## **Objective:**

Practice finding combinations of numbers within 10

### Materials:

- Shake and Spill Recording Sheets
- 2-sided colored counters
- Paper Cups

### **Directions:**

- Give students a recording sheet for the number they are working with that day. Have students start with small numbers (4 or 5), and over time have them use numbers from 4 to 10.
- Students place their assigned number of counters in a cup. They then shake the cup and spill out the counters.
- Students record the combination of colors they get by coloring the circles on their recording sheets.
- Have students repeat spilling the counters and coloring the circles until they have filled their sheets.

#### Early math content areas covered:

• Various combinations of numbers under 10.

## Monitoring children's progress and tailoring the activity appropriately:

• Start students with numbers three to five. As students become more proficient increase the numbers value.

## Using the activity to increase math talk in the classroom:

- Talk to students about all the ways they found to make their number.
- Ask them whether they think they found all the different ways. Have students explain their answers.
